Indiana City Brewing Co. celebrates 3rd Anniversary with local music lineup, burlesque

INDIANAPOLIS, May 23, 2016—On a stovetop in a small Chicago apartment, a dream began to brew. Now, three years after the grand opening of Indiana City Brewing Company, one of Indianapolis' smallest breweries has seen tremendous growth—a reason to celebrate. Indiana City will host its 3rd Anniversary Party on May 28, 2016 from 2 p.m. to 10 p.m. at 24 Shelby Street.

This all-day race weekend event is free to the public and will include local musical acts such as Sirius Black and John Stamps, Sacred Leather, Louie Louie, DJ Action Jackson and more. A special burlesque performance by Indianapolis' Rocket Doll Revue will take place later in the evening. Collaborative artwork by Indy's Craft Brew Doodle Crew will be on display and available for purchase throughout the day. Food trucks will be on site for patrons to purchase from.

In preparation for the party, the brewers at Indiana City crafted the 2016 Anniversary Ale, a complex beer made from 16 grain and seven hop varieties. The beer is made completely using the brewery's 2015 leftovers—grain and hops that still remained from past brews. The end result is a beer deep copper in color featuring a big hop aroma, weighing in at 8.5% ABV and 93 IBU. The 2016 Anniversary Ale will be released at the party beginning at 2 p.m.

"We've had a very successful first three years thanks to Indy's beer lovers and their demand for high quality, small-batch local beer," founder Ray Kamstra said, "It's their amazing support for our passion for brewing that has allowed us to grow and spread our beer across the city."

Giving back has always been part of the Indiana City philosophy. The brewery is excited to celebrate another successful year sharing their passion and supporting the passions of the local artists they have chosen to feature for this year's celebration. They hope that Indianapolis joins them in celebrating the vibrant talent that makes Indianapolis great.
